This person must have achieved recognition at the state level for ability in the game or made outstanding contributions to the good and welfare of the game through administrative or organizational work, or in any other manner deemed meritorious. This person must have been a member of the **Nebraska** USBC Bowling Association or the former NWBA, NBA, WIBC, or ABC for at least ten (10) years. Posthumous awards may be presented. Information must be complete as to **time, dates, and places**.

Remember that this nomination is for the Nebraska Hall of Fame and the only scores, championships, honors, contributions, etc. that will be considered are those that you earned while a member of the Nebraska USBC.
